

If any guests in your group are unable or choose not to participate in an attraction, there's a solution!

If a child doesn't meet the height requirement or a guest prefers not to join a specific attraction, don't worry! With Rider Switch, one adult can stay with the non-riding individuals while the rest of the group enjoys the attraction. Once the other adult returns, they can supervise the non-riders, and the waiting adult can board the attraction without queuing again.

Rider Switch is offered at selected attractions across all four Walt Disney World Resort theme parks. How to Use Rider Switch:

- Check with a Cast member to confirm if Rider Switch is available for the attraction.
- Approach the greeting Cast Member at the attraction with your entire party. One adult and the non-riding guests will receive a Rider Switch entitlement and wait in a designated area (usually outside the attraction) as "Party 2."
- The remaining party members ("Party 1") ride the attraction.
- After the ride, Party 1 joins Party 2. Party 1 then takes charge of supervising the non-riders.
- Party 2 can enter and ride the attraction without waiting in line again. A Cast Member must validate the Rider Switch entitlement at this point.

Please note that if Party 1 utilizes a lightning lane entrance, Party 2 must also have a valid lightning lane.
